Dr. Szarina Abdullah is currently Principal Consultant at Wisdom Synergy Consulting, Shah Alam, Malaysia. Prior to joining the company, she was Professor at the Faculty of Information Management, Universiti Teknologi MARA, Shah Alam. She was a lead researcher / consultant who conducted three national bibliometric studies of Malaysia's science & technology knowledge productivity for the Ministry of Science, Technology, and Innovation, Malaysia. Findings from these studies have implications for policymakers, university administrators, researchers, and academics engaged in R&D activities, and were tabled to the Cabinet in August 2004 by the Minister. Since then, Malaysian academics and researchers have become aware of the importance of citation studies and their use in the assessment of science productivity, and ranking of universities. It has also led to the establishment of a national database for S&T indicators under the Malaysian Science & Technology Information Centre. She has conducted workshops for various groups of academics, researchers and librarians in and outside Malaysia.
