SYNOPSIS

Project/ problem-based learning (PBL) is a student or learner-centred teaching method in which it encourages the learners to participate actively throughout the learning process. PBL places partial and explicit responsibility on the students' shoulders for their own learning. Unlike the conventional stand-and deliver lecturer-centred approach where students listen passively to lectures, PBL emphasizes active, interactive and collaborative learning making it more student-centred. Thus, PBL makes use of problems to focus learning whereby students develop problem solving skills whilst searching for and gaining the appropriate knowledge.

- ✦ design a project based on the curriculum
- ✦ develop and refine good Driving Question
- ✦ prepare documents for PBL
- ✦ implement the project as planned
