DEFINING THE NEW — REDISCOVERING THE FAMILIAR

German-American jazz pianist Benny Lackner lived in the US almost 20 years and about half of that in NYC. He studied at the California Institute of the Arts under the direction of Charlie Haden and his mentor Brad Mehldau. He played many major jazz clubs and festivals and formed his own trio that got a name for its personal way of interpreting standards as well as covers of songs of the current generation. The Benny Lackner Trio's approach to both its original material and compositions ranging from Monk to Prince fuses intensity with unintrusive virtuosity. These reharmonizations of the familiar give the traditional form of piano trio a new identity and purpose in our own time. Benny Lackner will be accompanied by Jerome Regard on bass and Matthieu Chazarence on drums.
