Requirements for Postgraduate Research Students - ISI Publications

1. ISI Web of Science (WoS) publications – Students must provide proof of acceptance before the viva-voce. ISI WoS publications include articles in journals and proceedings with impact factor.
2. Authorship – The student must be the first author or, either the second or subsequent author after the supervisor(s); or the first student author. In the event two or more students co-author an article, only one student is allowed to use this article to fulfill his/her graduation requirement.
3. Timing – Publications accepted must be within the student's candidature.
4. Topic of publications – Must be related and conform to the student's research.
5. Affiliation – Publications must carry the affiliation of the department and/or faculty where the student is registered.

Note:

The above are applicable to all research candidates except for number 1. Non-Science students will have to refer to the category A and B publication lists endorsed by the faculty.
